Beach Wrestling World Series Ranking

Rule Book





Beach Wrestling World Series Ranking - Rule Book

1. The BWWS is the men's and women's elite competition consisting of the best wrestlers competing in a World Series of events.
2. The BWWS is used to determine the BW Men's World Titles and the BW Women's World Titles. The winners of each weight category are referred to as the BW World Champions.
3. The BW World Titles are given to the wrestlers with the most accumulated points from their respective weight categories from the BWWS events.
4. Event results are converted to points and count towards the BW World Title and the ultimate prize of being called the BW World Champion.
5. BWWS wrestlers accumulate points from each event they compete in, which count towards their BWWS Ranking. Accumulated points are valid for 12 months from the final date of the scheduled event in which they were earned (no points from the previous year can be used to determine the BW World Champion of a given year).
6. Points for the BWWS events are distributed according to Table A and the following principles:
 - a) Ranking per weight category;
 - b) To promote participation it will be used a seeded system based on the accumulated ranking so far;
 - c) The events will have a simple scoring for the BWWS ranking;
 - d) In the odd situation that there are less than 24 wrestlers in a given category in a given event, the Table points will remain the same.

7. Points for the BWWS Final are distributed according to the following formula:
 - (Position Points according Table A) x (total number of events without the Final)

For example a 1st placed wrestler in the final of a BWWS with 4 events plus the final would get 40 000 points (10 000 x 4 = 40 000).



8. Ranking criteria in case of a tie between athletes

In case of a tie in the ranking between two or more athletes, we will determine the best of them following these criteria:

- Rank in the last Beach Wrestling World Series Final
- Highest number of participation in the Beach Wrestling World Series events*
- Highest number of Gold Medals in the Beach Wrestling World Series events*
- Highest number of Silver Medals in the Beach Wrestling World Series events*
- Highest number of Bronze Medals in the Beach Wrestling World Series events*
- The most classification points in the Beach Wrestling World Series events*
- The most technical points scored in Beach Wrestling World Series events*

**numbers taken during all events from the current season and all events of the previous season minus the number of events already disputed in the current season (cutoff from the oldest).*



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
